**Present Simple – To be**

**To be is one of the most common verbs in English. It means Ser and Estar.**

I <b>am</b> in Rancagua I <b>am</b> a teacher	Yo <b>estoy</b> en Rancagua Yo <b>soy</b> un profesor
She <b>is</b> in Rancagua She <b>is</b> a teacher	Ella <b>está</b> en Rancagua Ella <b>es</b> una profesora
We <b>are</b> in Rancagua We <b>are</b> teachers	Nosotros <b>estamos</b> en Rancagua Nosotros <b>somos</b> profesores

**In present tense, To be has 3 forms:**

Pronoun	Be	Example
I	Am	I am happy
He – she – it	Is	He is Happy
You – we – they	Are	You are Happy

**Let's remember personal pronouns**

I	yo
We	Nosotros
He	Él
She	Ella
It	Eso (Cosas y 1nimals)
They	Ellas/Ellos/Esos/Esas
You	Tú/ustedes
