Present Simple – To be

To be is one of the most common verbs in English. It means <u>Ser</u> and <u>Estar</u>.

I am in Rancagua	Yo estoy en Rancagua
I am a teacher	Yo soy un profesor
She is in Rancagua	Ella está en Rancagua
She is a teacher	Ella es una profesora
We are in Rancagua	Nosotros estamos en Rancagua
We are teachers	Nosotros somos profesores

In present tense, To be has 3 forms:

Pronoun	Be	Example
1	Am	I am happy
He – she – it	Is	He is Happy
You – we – they	Are	You are Happy
