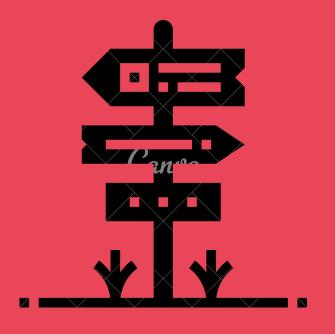

WE USE THEM TO TALK ABOUT MONTHS, YEARS, DATES AND TIME.

- Months and years----> IN

- Dates----> ON

- Times----> AT

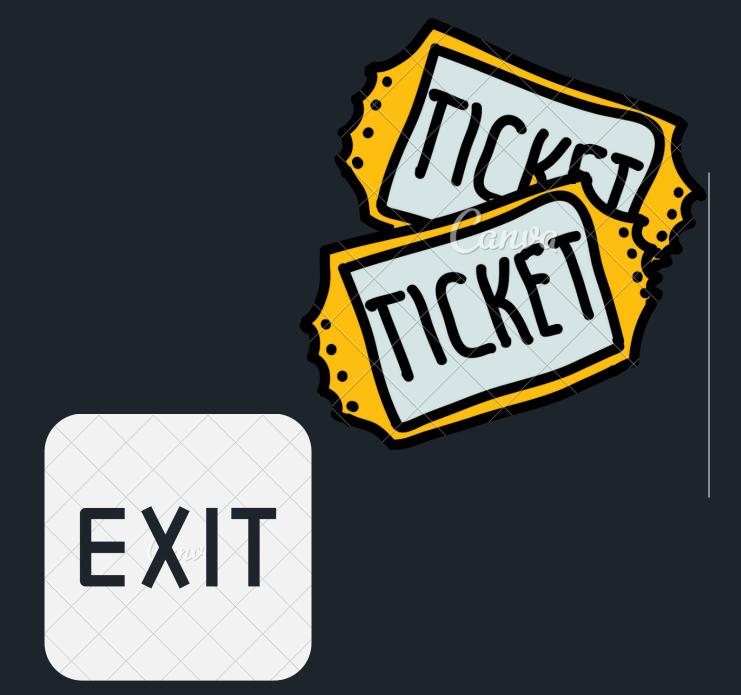
